## **ASSOCIATION OF COSMETIC TATTOO INC ETHICAL CODE OF PRACTICE**

1. Members are to maintain high professional standards consistent with sound practices.
2. Members are to conduct business relationships in a manner that is fair to all.
3. Members will promote professionalism in the cosmetic tattoo/semipermanent makeup industry without discrimination against any fellow technician's background.
4. Members will further the interests of the Association and encourage cooperation throughout the cosmetic tattoo industry.
5. Members will refrain from any immoral or unethical behaviour in their business dealings.
6. Technicians will strive to participate in continuing education to upgrade and improve their knowledge and skills.
7. Technicians understand they must follow OH & S guidelines with regard to sterilisation for the cosmetic tattoo industry.
8. Technicians will use machines that have sterilised or sterile disposable tubes, needles and tips which can be totally removed from the machine.
9. Members agree the application of semi-permanent makeup is in fact tattooing. Technicians will not deceive their clients regarding this aspect of semi-permanent cosmetics by stating "this is not tattooing."
10. Members understand the process of tattooing is semi-permanent and not completely painless. Members will make no false or misleading statements to the public in their advertisements, brochures, or consultation materials regarding the process of tattooing.
11. Members may not appropriate any Association materials, including items such as articles, videos, images and membership lists for their own personal gain. Members may not reproduce or use any of said materials, including the membership list, for any reason without the prior written approval of the Board of ACT
